

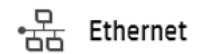
## HP PRODUCT QUICK GUIDE

### CUSTOMIZE THE HOME SCREEN

Objective: Customize the home screen of the MFP using the device's webpage

1. Obtain the IP address of the MFP


- At the MFP, click the blue "i" 
- Then, select the "Ethernet" button to display the machine's information
- The IPv4 address will be used to access the MFP web page



2. Access the web page by typing the IP address of the MFP to a browser on the same network as the MFP. Do not add www or http to the number, just type in the IP address.

3. In the top right corner, use the "sign in" button to log in as an admin. Unless a password has been set, no password is needed.

4. Navigate to the "General" tab on the top bar

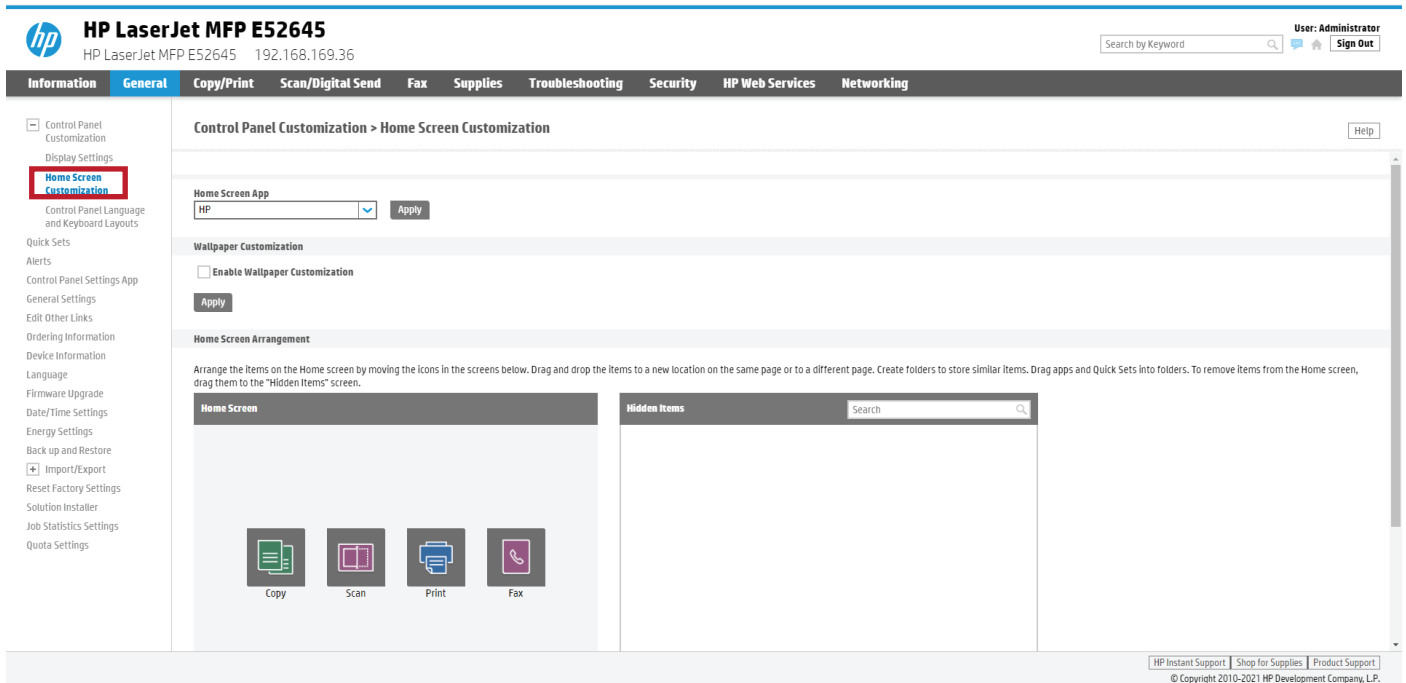
